



# SIN CITY CHAPTER

## DRIVING SCHOOL

### POLICIES

#### Applications

The chapter reserves the right to refuse an application for any reason.

#### Cancellations

Cancellations will be accepted up to 21 days before the event, but there will be a \$35 service charge. Cancellations less than 21 days before the event will be refunded only if the space can be filled by another student and the \$35 service charge will apply. Entries are non-transferable.

#### Convertibles (Soft Top or Hard Top)

Convertibles (soft top or hard top) must have a SCCA-approved roll bar that clears the occupants' helmeted heads by 2 inches and 5- or 6-point harnesses for BOTH seats. Factory rollover protection is not acceptable as a roll bar. Factory hardtops do not provide a substitute for a roll bar. Arm restraints are **STRONGLY** recommended. Convertibles must be identified on the application. The Sin City Chapter reserves the right to refuse any convertible application after conferring with the Chief Steward.

#### Car Insurance Requirements

All cars must be registered, insured and have valid license plates.

#### Mechanical Failures

If a car breaks or the driver deems it as undriveable during the school (regardless of reason), there will be no refund of fees.

#### Requirements for Drivers

All drivers must have a valid, unrestricted driver's license and must be 18 years of age or older.

### Spectators

Spectators are allowed at the event provided they sign the liability waiver before entering the track area. Children under 18 require a special parental consent waiver that must be signed by **both** parents or one parent's signature and affirmation that they have sole custody.

### Technical Inspections

The Pre-Event Technical Inspection Form must be completed and signed before arriving at the Driving School. Participants are totally responsible for the mechanical condition of your vehicle. If a car arrives without a technical inspection, it will not be allowed on the track and there will be no refund of fees. The Sin City Chapter will not conduct a technical inspection of cars at the track.
